- the new Act requirements in place prior to service delivery. These will be reviewed annually. Existing clients will receive a call during the coming year to review their services and receive a Service Agreement.
- More Flexibility you'll have greater say in how and when services are delivered.

Behind the scenes, our team has updated systems, policies, and training to align with the new **Aged Care Act**, ensuring St George Community remains a trusted, high-quality provider of care and connection for years to come.

In 2025, we also introduced new safety and wellbeing measures, from refreshed driver and passenger protocols to ongoing staff education, all aimed at keeping our services welcoming, reliable, and safe for every person who travels with us.

Our contribution was even recognised in the **NSW Parliament**, where Premier Chris Minns commended St George Community for over 40 years of outstanding service. It's a moment of pride for our entire team, but especially for those who've been part of this journey from the very beginning.

And, of course, we've kept the fun going! Whether it's creative mystery trips, cultural escapes, or scenic getaways, our social program continues to grow thanks to your feedback and enthusiasm. 
